Digital Media: electronic devices and media platforms such as computers, cell phones, video, the Internet, and video games that allow users to create, communicate, and interact with one another or with the device or application itself.

Digital Citizenship: a member of a worldwide community linked by the Internet and who navigates the digital world safely, responsibly, and ethically. Fair Use: the ability to use a small amount of someone's creative work without permission, but only in certain ways commercial purposes: a use in connection with a business, usually for profit.

Copyright: a law that protects a creator's ownership of and control over the work he or she creates, requiring other people to get the creator's permission before they copy, share, or perform that work.

Creative Commons: a kind of copyright that makes it easy for people to copy, share, and build on someone's creative work – as long as they give the creator credit for it.

Public Domain: creative work that's not protected by copyright and is therefore free for one to use however one wants.

Citizen: member of a group or community.

Right: a protected freedom; something that a person is or should be morally or legally allowed to have, get, or do.

Responsibility: a duty or task that you are required or expected to do; something that you should do because it is morally right, legally required, etc
